

Kitty City Quilt

62" x 52"

Fabric:

1. Fish Bones-C12472_white - 1/4 yd
2. Kitty City Words-C12468_black - 1/4 yd
3. Heart Paw Prints-C12470_red - 2 yards
4. Live, Love, Purr-C12469_Dark Blue - 1/4 yd
5. Kitty City Scenic-C12465_blue - 1/4 yd
6. 2. Heart Paw Prints-C12470_navy - 1 1/8 yard
7. Kitty City Panel-C12464_multi




Assemble as shown.

1. Cut panel to measure 42.5" x 22.5"

- 2a. Cut (2) 2.5" strips of each fabric: Fabric 1-Fish Bones, Fabric 2-Words, Fabric 3-Red Hearts, Fabric 4-Blue cats, Fabric 5-Scenic Houses. Cut the strips in half so you have (4) strips of each (2.5" x 21" - this helps to have straighter strip sets).

Strip sew the five fabrics as shown below. Repeat to make (3) strip sets total. Press seams and then cut each set into (8) 2.5" pieces. You will have a total of 24 strips.

Cut (8) 2.5" x 2.5" squares from excess strips: You will need (5) from fabric 1, (1) from fabric 2, & (2) from fabric 5.



- 2b. Sew (2) strip set pieces together to make 1 long strip, then sew on one more 2.5" square of fabric 1 as shown.


Repeat to make another set.

Sew strip 2b to each side of panel



- 2c. Sew (4) strip set pieces to make one long strip, then sew on (3) more 2.5" squares of fabric 1, fabric 2, & fabric 5 as shown.

Sew to bottom of panel



- 2d. Sew (3) strip set pieces together, then sew on more (1) 2.5 square of fabric 5 as shown. Set aside for step 4a.



3. Cut (5) 1.5" strips of Heart Paw Print Navy.

Sew a strip on each side of panel. Press and trim.

Sew 2 strips together on the short end to make one long strip. Sew to bottom of panel. Press and trim.

3a. Cut (4) 3.5" strips Heart Paw Print Navy. Sew (2) together on short ends to make one long strip. Repeat. Set a side for step 9.

4a. From the last Heart Paw Print Navy strip of step 3, Cut a 1.5" x 2.5" piece and sew to left side of strip set piece from 2d.

4b. Sew remaining piece of 1.5" strip of Heart Paw Print Navy along top of strip set piece from 2d. Press seam and trim.



5a. Cut (7) 7.5" strips of Heart Paw Print Red. Sew (2) of these strips together on short ends and sew to *bottom* of panel. Press and trim.

Sew one strip along top of blue from 4b. Press seam, trim and set aside until step 7. See layout shown on page 1.

5b. Sew (2) of the red strips together on short ends. Repeat for last (2) strips. Set aside until step 8.

6. CAT:

Heart Paw Print Red:

Cut (1) 5.5" strip then cut the following from this strip:

(1) 6.5" x 4.5" piece, (1) 5.5" x 9.5" piece, (1) 5.5 x 3.5" piece, and (1) 5" x 5" square to make half square triangles.

Cut (1) 1.5" strip then cut the following:

(2) 1.5" x 4.5" pieces, (1) 1.5 x 15.5" piece, and (1) 1.5" x 2.5" piece.

Heart Paw Print Navy:

Cut (1) 5" strip then cut the following from this strip:

(1) 2.5" x 4.5" piece, (1) 4.5" x 4.5" piece, and (1) 5" x 5" square to make half square triangles.

Cut (1) 1.5" Strip then cut that into the following:


(2) 1.5" x 3.5" pieces, (1) 1.5" x 2.5" piece, and (1) 1.5" x 1.5" square.

Making (8) Half Square Triangles - Using the Red and Navy 5" x 5" squares, right sides together pair up and draw 2 diagonal lines on the wrong side of red fabric.

Using the diagonal lines as guides, sew 1/4" seam on **BOTH SIDES of diagonal lines (DON'T SEW ON THE LINE)**.


Make (4) 2.5" squares by cutting in half and in half again. Cut the diagonal lines of those pieces to make 8 triangles.

Gently press towards the blue color; do not want to stretch your square. Square carefully to 1.5".



Cut into 8 triangles

How to assemble & sew the cut pieces for cat



Sew pieces together as shown.

*Best to press away from half-square triangles when sewing pieces together.

7. Sew the piece from step 5a to the left side Cat block from step 6. Sew to top of panel. See layout shown on page 1.

8. Use these strips from 5b to sew to each sides of panel. Press and trim.

9. Sew each strip from step 3a along top and bottom of panel. Press and trim.

10. Sew (6) strip set pieces from step 2 together to make one long set for top, then sew (1) more 2.5" squares fabric 1. Sew to top of quilt.



Repeat to make another set for bottom.

Before adding backing, sew a seam along the edge of top and bottom. The will help keep the seams from pulling apart when finishing quilt.
