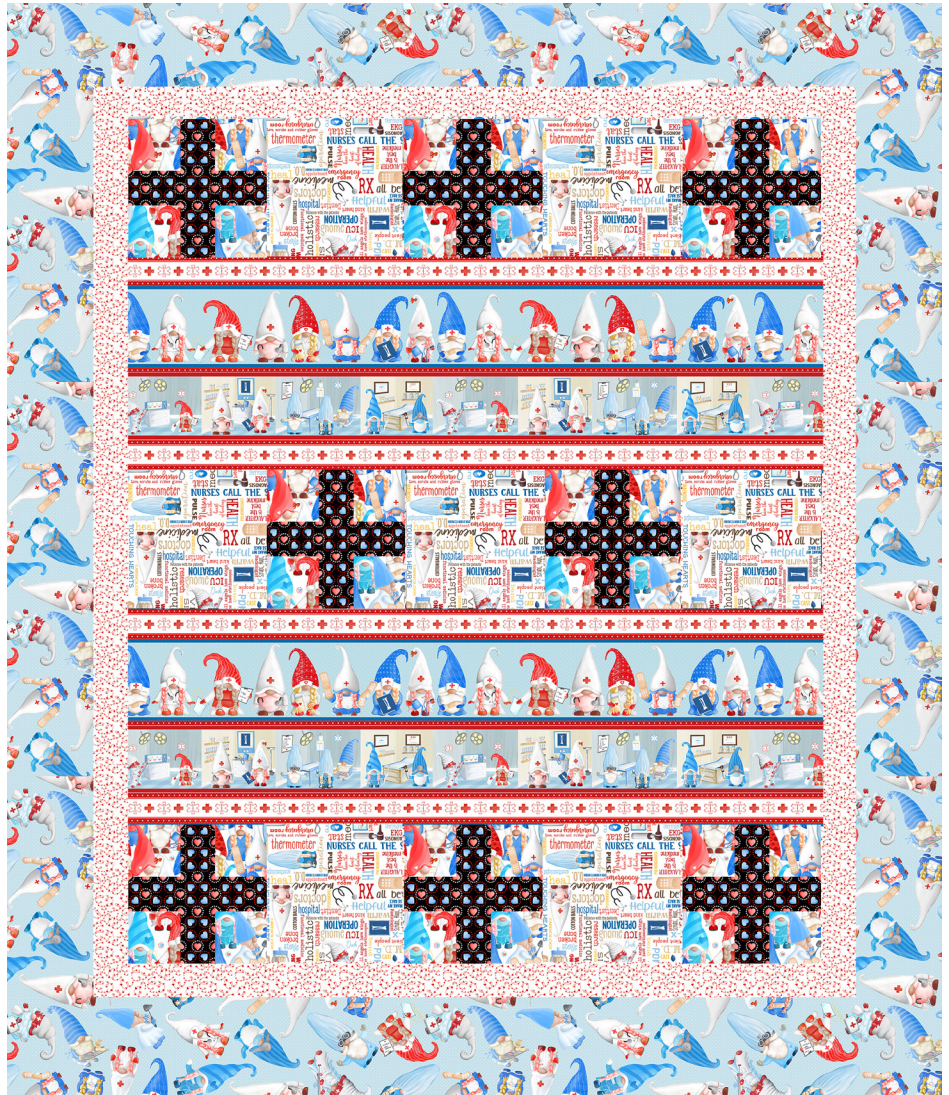


Caring Gnomes Free Quilt

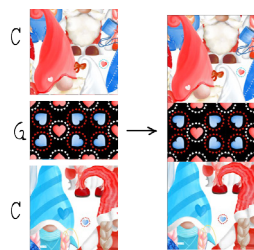

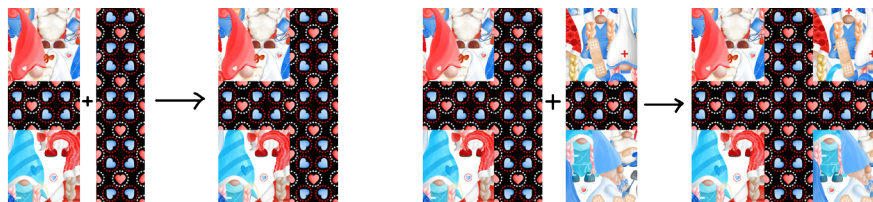
Use a .25" Seam Allowance • RST = Right sides together

A 14110 Caring Gnome Stripe .....	1 1/4 yard	Fussy cut (2) 12.75" x 40.5
B 14111 Caring Gnome Words White .....	1/2 yard	Cut (7) 8.5 x 8.5" squares
C 14114 Caring Gnomes Stacked .....	1/3 yard	Cut (32) 3.5" x 3.5" squares
D 14115 Swirling Hearts White .....	1/2 yard	Cut (6) 2.5" Strips (Border 1)
E 14116 Caring Gnome Tossed Lt Blue .....	1 1/2 yard	Cut (8) 6.5" Strips (Border 2)
F 14117 Circle Hearts Black .....	1/3 yard	Cut (8) 2.5 x 8.5"
G 14117 Circle Hearts Black .....		Cut (16) 2.5" x 3.5"

1. RST, Sew C to both sides of G



2. RST, sew CGC from Step 1 to both sides of F. Press. This creates the block.



3. Layout the rows with the Block created in Step 2 and B Squares in the rows and the fussy cut stripe A in between as shown in sample quilt on page 1.

Sew Blocks together, then the rows together. Press

4. Sew top and bottom of quilt with D-Border 1, Press and Trim.

5. Sew remaining border strips together in sets of (2).

6. Sew sides of quilt with the remaining D-Border 1 strips. Press and Trim.

7. Repeat for Border 2 on top and bottom, then on sides. Finish as desired.

8. Optional: Using template trace and cut (2) hearts from excess fabric. RST, sew around edge leaving an opening for turning. Turn, press, sew closed. Hand stitch to quilt leaving an 1" of thread sew the heart dangles off the quilt edge - it's a nice reminder of the people who care for us.
