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## Whatyou need:

A 14685 Birds of Paradise-Multi $\qquad$ 1 yard
B 14686 Tropical Flower Buds-Light Green .... $2 / 3$ yard
C 14688 Tropical Refreshments-White $\qquad$ 1/2 yard
D 14689 Tropical Leaves-White-Green $1 / 2$ yard
E 14690 Tropical Butterflies-Light Blue 2/3 yard
F 14691 Island Time Signs-White-Multi.......... 1 3/4 yard
G 14692 Tropical Fruit Slices -White $\qquad$ 1 yard

Optional: 3.5 yards of fun fringe for top and bottom of quilt
Key:
Use a $1 / 4$ " Seam allowance, unless otherwise noted
RST=Right sides together: when sthip seving you a aways stait with, RST
Right side of fabiuc whong side of fabric
It's always best to press your seams


Block B - 17


Cut strips first, then into the sizes below
You need (18) of each piece for Block A and (17) of each for Block B

| C 14688 Tropical Refreshments-White | Cut (6) @ 2.5" | into $2.5 \times 10.5$ " |  |  |
| D 14689 Tropical Leaves-White-Green |  |  | Cut (6) @ 2.5" | into $2.5 \times 10.5$ " |
| E 14690 Tropical Butterflies-Light Blue | Cut (3) @ 3.5" | into $3.5 \times 5.5$ " | Cut (3) @ 3.5" | into $3.5 \times 5.5$ " |
| F 14691 Island Time Signs-White- | Cut (2) @ 8.5" | into $8.5 \times 4.5$ " |  |  |
| G 14692 Tropical Fruit Slices -White |  |  | Cut (3) @ 3.5" | into $3.5 \times 6 .{ }^{\prime \prime}$ |

Block A - you will make 18


1. Sew pieces in Block A in the order shown; Piece 1 to 2 , then to 3 . Press after each piece is sewn together. Square to $10.5^{\prime \prime}$.

Block B - you will make 17

2. Sew pieces in Block B in the order shown; Piece 1 to 2 , then to 3. Press after each piece is sewn together.
Square to $10.5^{\prime \prime}$.
3. Randomly sew blocks together, rotate and alternate them or use sample quilt on page 1 as a guide. The quilt will be 5 blocks wide by 7 blocks tall.
4. Sew (2) Border 1 strips together on the short ends to make one long border strip. Repeat for the remaining border strips. Sew Border 1 on the sides, press and trim. Sew Border 1 on the top and bottom, press and trim.
Repeat for Border 2.
Finish as desired.
Optional: After sewing on binding, use a large zig zag stitch to sew fringe to the top and bottom of binding on the quilt for a more tropical relaxed vibe.
