Flamingal Pals Quilt by Andi Metz $70 "$ x 80 "


Use . 25 Seam Allowance - RST=Right Sides Together



1. Strip Sew C to A. Cut into (30) $4.5^{\prime \prime}$ pieces.

Press. Trim.
Strip Sew C to bottom of block as shown.


Press.

Sew CA to E. Cut into (30) 5.5" pieces.
Rotate (15) CA/E and sew right sides together to another CA/E to create Block 1 as shown. Make (15).

## BLOCK 2 - Pieces


2. Using the $12.5^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{A} \& \mathrm{D}$ squares, pin right sides together to
 make half-square triangles. You will be creating 8 at a time.

## Half Square Triangles - 8 at a time

Draw 2 diagonal lines on the wrong side of lighter fabric.
RST, using the diagonal lines as guides, sew squares together by sewing $1 / 4$ " seam on BOTH SIDES of diagonal lines (DON'T SEW ONTHELINE).
Cut (4) 6.25 " squares by cutting in half and in half again. Cut the diagonal lines of those pieces to make 8 triangles. Gently press open; you do not want to stretch your square. Square to 5.5 ". Repeat for all pairs of squares.

3. Strip sew B to C. Press and cut into 3 " pieces as shown. Rotate a $B C$ and sew to another BC, right sides together to create four square block. Press.


Sew AD to the BC four square block, right sides together as shown. Make (30)


Rotate (15) $\mathrm{AD} / \mathrm{BC}$ and sew right sides together to another $\mathrm{AD} / \mathrm{BC}$ with right sides together to create Block 2. Make (15)


ROTATE \& SEW TOGETHER
4. Arrange blocks as shown on page one to create quilt top. Sew together.
5. Sew border strips together to make 2 sets of each border fabric. Sew border 1 on sides, press and trim excess. Sew border 1 on top and bottom, press and trim excess. Repeat for border $2 \& 3$. Finish quilt as desired.
