Flamingo Friends Quilt by Andi Metz 70" x 89.5"

This quilt uses only one block template which is rotated to create the pattern and it is a very easy block to create.

What you need:

12591	Flamingo Stripe-	1 1/8 yd
12593	Flip Flop Fun-pink	2 yds
12598	Floral Paradise-white	1 1/3 yd
12599	Fun In The Sun Words-white	1 1/8
12600	Fun In The Sun Motifs-white	1 1/8

- A. Cut (7) 5.5" strips of Fun in the Sun Words
- B. Cut (7) 5.5" strips of Fun in the Sun Motifs
- C. Cut (14) 3" strips of Flip Flop Fun
- D. Cut (14) 3" strips of Floral Paradise
- E. Cut (4) 5.5" strips of Flip Flop Fun
- F. Fussy Cut (4) 5" x 40.5" Strips of Flamingo Gals from Flamingo Stripe Fabric



- 1. Strip sew pieces C & D. Press seams Cut into 3" pieces. You will need 192 pieces.
- 2. Arrange and sew together pieces as shown to create the four-patch block. You will need 96 four-patch blocks



3. Strip sew four-patch blocks to A as shown. Press away from four-patch block. Cut into 5.5" pieces. You will need 48.



- 4. Strip sew four-patch blocks to B as shown. Press away from four-patch block. Cut into 5.5" pieces. You will need 48.
- 5. Sew together 1 piece from step 3 and 1 piece from step 4 to make block as shown. Repeat to make 48 blocks.
- 6. Arrange blocks as shown: 6 x 8 rotating as needed and sew together. Sew (2) E pieces together on short end to make one long strip. Sew to side of quilt. Repeat for the other side.
- 7. Sew (2) Flamingo Strips together on short ends to create one long strip. Sew to top of quilt. Repeat for bottom of quilt. Finish Quilt as desired.
